

ORDINANCE #2-2006
TOWN OF HOLLAND ORDINANCE TO
PROHIBIT SMOKING IN THE TOWN HALL

The Holland Town Board, Township of Holland, La Crosse County, does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Purpose.

The purpose of this ordinance is to promote the safety, health and general welfare by regulating smoking in the Town Hall.

Section 2. Authority; Establishment.

The Town Board of the Town of Holland, having been authorized by the Town meeting under Sec. 60.10(2)(c), Wis. Stats., to exercise village powers, hereby exercises village powers under Sec. 287.09, Wis. Stats.

Section 3. General Provisions.

No person shall cause, allow or permit any person to smoke cigarettes, cigars, pipes or other devices containing tobacco or other combustible smoking materials in the Town Hall.

Section 4. Enforcement and Penalties.

Any person who violates, disobeys or refuses to comply with or who resists the enforcement of any provisions of this Ordinance, shall upon conviction be fined not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$200.00 for each offense, together with costs of prosecution.

Section 5. Effective date.

Following passage by the Town Board, this ordinance shall take effect the day after the date of publication or posting as provided by sec. 60.80, Wis. Stats.
