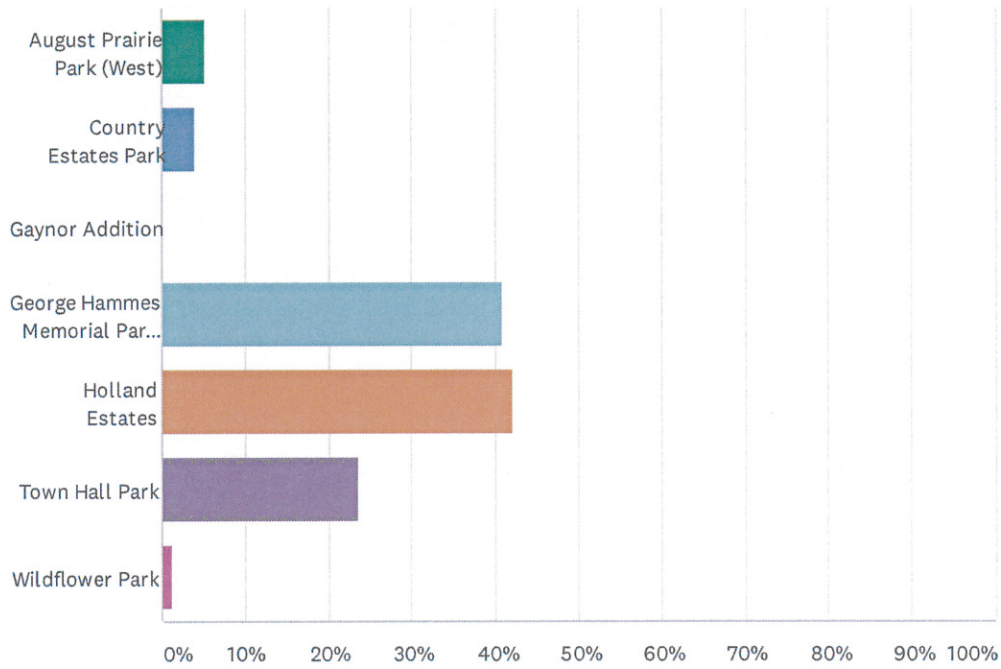


### Q1 Please select the park that you utilize or associate most with.

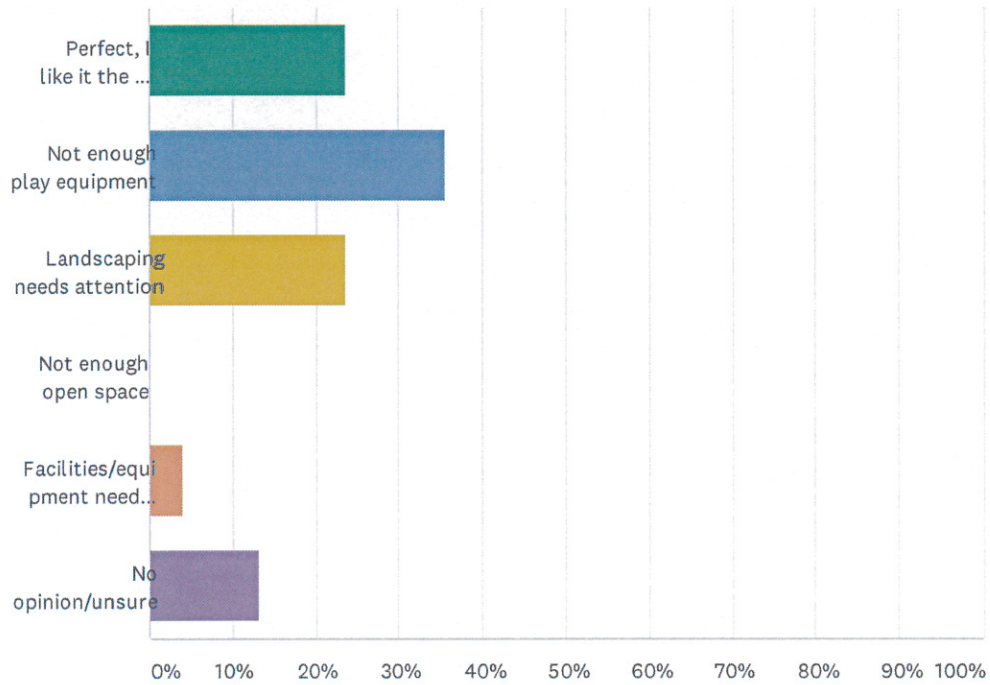

### Q3 How do you feel about the park you selected above?

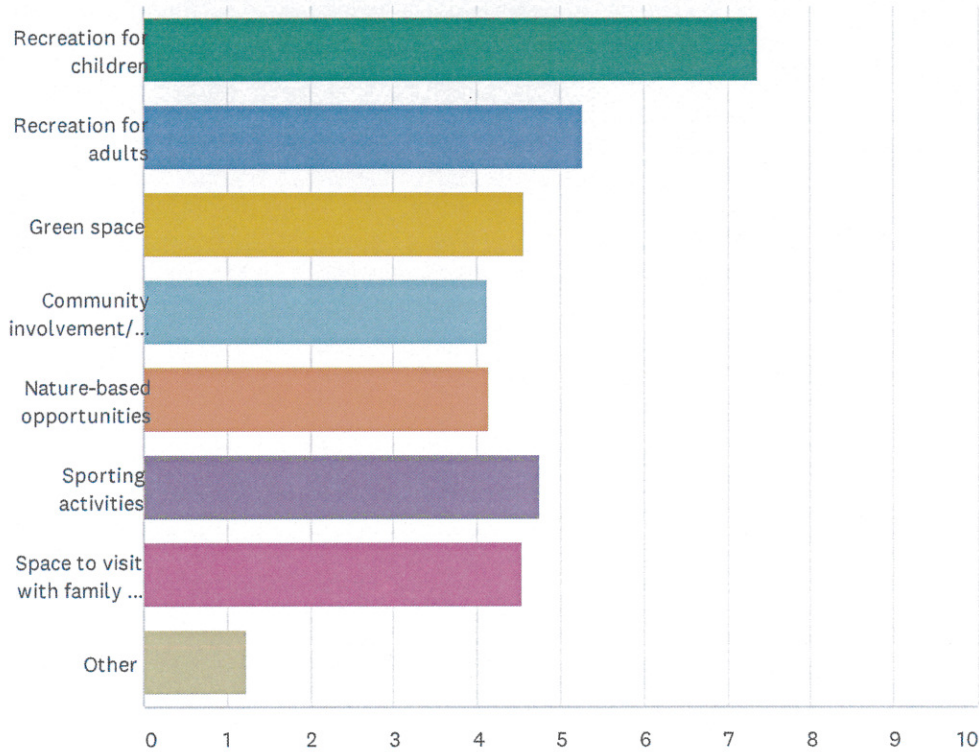

## Q2 Please rank the following components to a Town neighborhood park in order from the most important to the least important. (1 being most important)

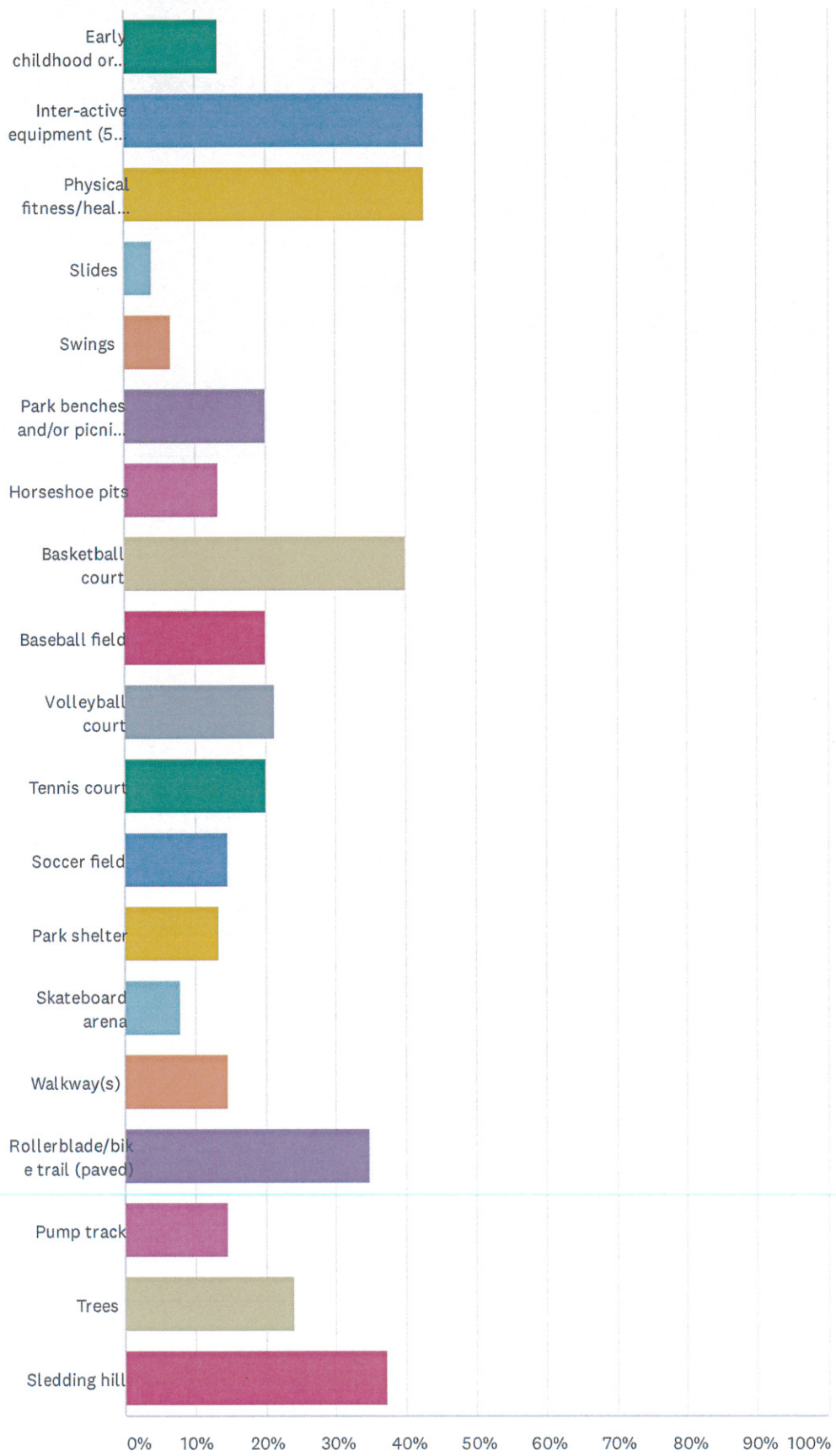

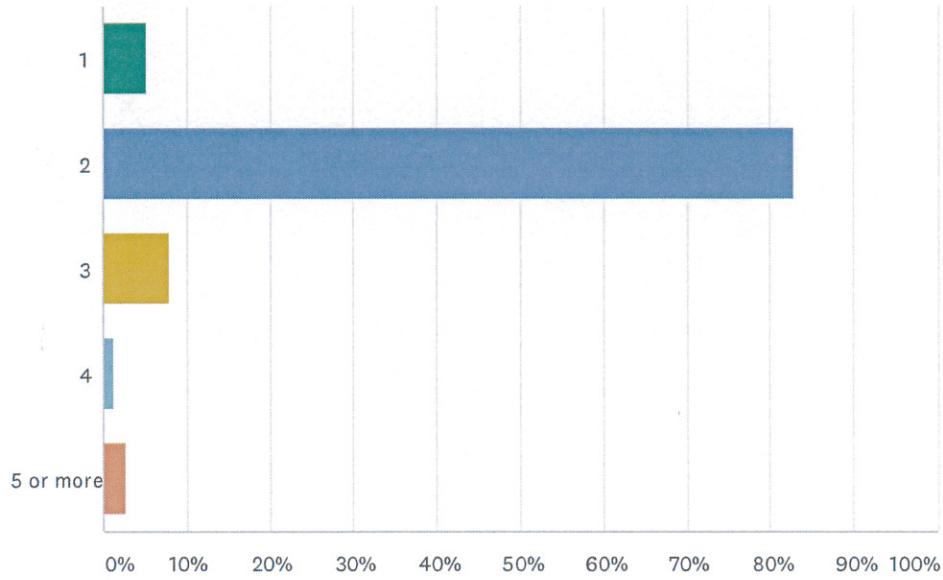

### Q6 Number of adults in your home

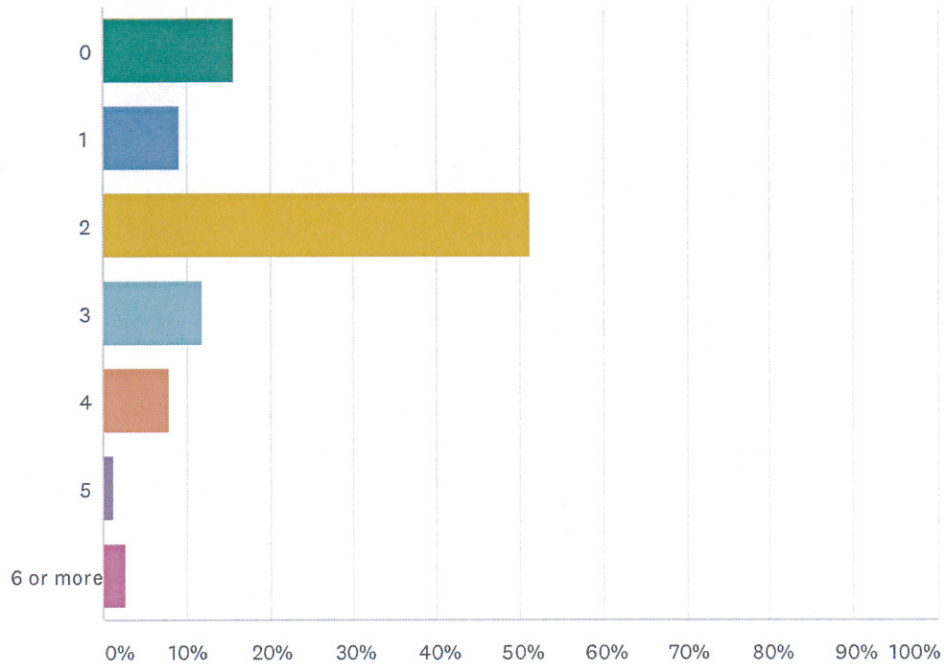
