CALL TO ORDER

Chair Stupi called the meeting to order at 6:32 p.m. Notices were published and posted as required by law.

Stupi reported the first item for the meeting was for the electors to vote on the 2021 Town levy. Clerk Pedretti read the following into the record:

RESOLUTION 2021-14

FOR ELECTORS TO ADOPT THE TOWN OF HOLLAND TAX LEVY

WHEREAS, Sec. 60.10(1)(a) of Wis. Statutes authorizes the Town electors of a Town to adopt the Town tax levy at a Town meeting of the electors; and

WHEREAS, a special Town meeting of the electors has been called and properly noticed to approve the 2021 total Town tax levy (to be collected in 2022), pursuant to Wis. Stat. Section 60.10(1)(a);

NOW THEREFORE, the special Town meeting of the Town of Holland, La Crosse County, Wisconsin, by a majority vote of the eligible electors duly assembled and voting on this 10th day of November, 2021, hereby resolves and orders as follows:

The Town Electors of the Town of Holland, La Crosse County, Wisconsin, hereby adopt the Town tax levy for 2021 (to be collected in 2022) in the amount of \$606,837.64 (including the approved levy of \$518,320 plus debt service payment of \$88,517.64).

The Town Clerk shall properly post this resolution as required by law under Sec. 60.80(1)(a) of Wis. Statutes within 30 days of the below noted adoption date. Adopted this 10th day of November, 2021, at a special meeting of the Town Electors.

Motion by Matt Nikolay/Dick Berg to approve. **MOTION** carried 10 yeas, 0 nays, 0 abstentions.

Stupi reported the second item was discussion on board pay. No input given.

Motion by Dick Berg/Jeff Paulson to adjourn. Motion carried. Hearing adjourned at 6:35 p.m.
