AMENDMENT #2 (2025) to ORDINANCE #1-2022 (Amended in 2023), DRIVEWAY, CULVERT AND RIGHT-OF-WAY ORDINANCE

AN AMENDMENT TO THE ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH DRIVEWAY, CULVERT AND RIGHT-OF-WAY LOCATION, DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION REQUIREMENTS IN THE TOWN OF HOLLAND

The Town Board of the Town of Holland, La Crosse County, Wisconsin, acting under the provisions of a Village Board, does ordain that under Section 1.0 the term "hardscape" is defined and under Section 2.0 an additional item be added at the beginning to specify when a driveway or right-of-way permit is required.

SECTION 1.0 INTRODUCTION

- 1.05 Definitions
 - (L) **Hardscape**: landscape materials in the built environment structures that are incorporated into a landscape. This can include paved areas, driveways, retaining walls, sleeper walls, stairs, walkways, and any other landscaping made up of hard wearing materials such as wood, stone, and concrete, as opposed to softscape, the horticultural elements of a landscape.

SECTION 2.0 GENERAL PROVISIONS

A driveway permit or right-of-way permit shall be required whenever work will be performed on or around a driveway or within the right-of-way. This would include, but not limited to, driveway replacement, culvert replacement, surface changes and/or hardscaping additions/alterations. Inground water systems are not permitted in the right-of-way. A permit is required to provide safe access, consistent practices and best use with current regulations.

Following passage by the Town Board, this Amendment #2 to Ordinance #1-2022 (amended in 2023) shall take effect the day after the date of publication or posting as provided by sec. 60.80, Wis. Stats.
